Word Study for "Everlasting Punishment"

Everlasting: owlam in Hebrew (5769)

Long duration; for ever; perpetual; always; continuous existence; indefinite or unending future, eternity

Mercy and kindness: checed: 2617 (Strong's Hebrew)

Kindness; lovingkindness; goodness; merciful; favor; faithfulness

Mercy: 1828 Webster's Dictinary

That benevolence, mildness or tenderness of heart which disposes a person to overlook injuries, ro to treat an offender better than he deserves;

The disposition that tempers justice and induces an injured person to forgive trespasses and injuries, and to forbear punishment, or inflict less than law or justice will warrant.

That which comes nearest to grace. It implies benevolence, tenderness, mildness, pity or compassion, and clemency.

Mercy is a distinguishing attribute of the Supreme Being.

An act or exercise of mercy or favor.

Pity; compassion; clemency

Charity or the duties of charity and benevolence

<u>kindness</u>:

good will; benevolence; that disposition which delights in contributing to the happiness of other kindness ever accompanies love.

Acts of good will; beneficence

Charity; hospitality; attentions to the wants of others





Diagram of Inner Courts





Jonah is swallowed by big fish






Jonah on dry ground
