### Soul:

(1828 Webster's Dictionary)

- the spiritual, rational and immortal substance of man
- the understanding
- the intellectual principle
- vital principle
- Spirit; essence; chief part
- Life; animation
- active power
- heart, affection

**SOUL** in Bible: used 458 times

(5315: Hebrew: *Nephesh*)

- A breathing creature
- Vitality; self; person; mind; living being
- That which breathes, the breathing substance or being
- The inner being of man
- Seat of emotions, passions, appetites
- Activity of mind; will; character

### Substance:

(1828 Webster's Dictionary)

- being; something existing by itself
- that which really exists
- the essential part; the main or material part
- something real; not imaginary; something solid
- body
- goods; estate; means of living

### Infinite:

- Without limits
- Unbounded; boundless; not circumscribed
- That which has no end; infinitely extended
- Indefinitely large, immense, great size
- Immeasurably
- Inconceivably great or extensive
- No limitation
- Can't measure

**GOOD** in Bible: used 655 times

2896: Hebrew *towb*

- Agreeable; pleasant; good
- Excellent
- Valuable
- Better
- Happy; prosperous; kind; morally good

**Good:** (1828 Webster's Dictionary)

- valid; legally firm; not weak or defective
- having strength adequate to its support
- complete, sufficiently perfect in its kind
- opposed to bad, imperfect, corrupted, impaired
- having moral qualities best adapted to its design and use, or the qualities which God's law requires;
- virtuous; pious; religious;
- conformable to moral law
- sound, perfect, uncorrupted, undamaged
- full, complete, useful, kind, benevolent
