## "Faith" Word Study

### WORD STUDY ON FAITH and Research: Hebrews 11:1, 3

### Hebrew 11:1 different translations

#### King James Bible

Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen.

#### <u>New International Version</u> Now faith is confidence in what we hope for and assurance about what we do not see.

<u>New Living Translation</u> Faith shows the reality of what we hope for; it is the evidence of things we cannot see.

### English Standard Version Now faith is the assurance of things hoped for, the conviction of things not seen.

### New American Standard Bible

Now faith is *the* certainty of *things* hoped for, a proof of things not seen.

1 Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen.

From ancient Aramaic: Faith is the assurance (conviction) of things you're expecting—of things now existing. It is the unveiling (discovery) of things not seen." Faith demands action steps in order that this 'unveiling' can take place.

"Faith is the substance of things not seen..." In ancient Aramaic, the word for substance is "piasa" meaning conviction, assurance, persuasion."

The KJV then continues..."the evidence of things not seen"...The word for evidence in Aramaic is "gilyana" which means "an unveiling, a revelation."

### Faith: 4102: *pistis*

Conviction of the truth of anything, persuasion; moral conviction of religious truth or the truthfulness of God especially reliance upon Christ for salvation;

The conviction that God exists and is the creator and ruler of all things, the provider and bestower of eternal salvation through Christ.

### Substance: 5287 hypostasis

Setting or placing under; substructure, foundation

That which has foundation, is firm That which has actual existence; real being The steadfastness of mind, firmness, courage, resolution, Confidence, firm trust, assurance

#### Hoped for: 1679 eipizo

To expect or confide; trust To hope; to wait for salvation with joy and full confidence

#### Evidence: 1650 elenchos

A proof, that by which a thing is proved or tested Conviction

#### Seen: 991 blepo

To see with the bodily eye To have the power of seeing Turn the eyes to anything Look at Perceive by the senses Metaph: To see with the mind's eye To have the power of understanding To discern mentally

Now faith or the conviction of the truth of anything is the substructure or foundation of salvation that is hoped for, the evidence of things not seen with the bodily eye.

3 Through faith we understand that the worlds were framed by the word of God, so that things which are seen were not ade of things which do appear.

"*Through faith we understand that the worlds* —generally signifies *the ages*, yet here the subsequent clause determines its signification to the material fabric of the world, comprehending the sun, moon, and stars, (called by Moses the heaven and the earth, Genesis 1:1,) by whose duration and revolutions time, consisting of days, months, years, and ages, is measured; *were framed* — *Formed, fashioned,* and *finished*" (*Benson Commentary, www.biblehub.com*).

"Through faith we understand that the worlds were framed - The first instance of the strength of faith which the apostle refers to is that by which we give credence to the declarations in the Scriptures about the work of creation; Genesis 1:1. This is selected first, evidently because it is

the first thing that occurs in the Bible, or is the first thing there narrated in relation to which there is the exercise of faith" (Barnes' Notes, <u>www.biblehub.com)</u>.

## "Faith" Word Study

Use of "faith" in healings of the Bible in the Gospels (this is not all of them)

When Jesus heard *it*, he marvelled, and said to them that followed, Verily I say unto you, I have not found so great faith, no, not in Israel. (Matthew 8:10)

And, behold, they brought to him a man sick of the palsy, lying on a bed: and Jesus seeing their faith said unto the sick of the palsy; Son, be of good cheer; thy sins be forgiven thee. (Matthew 9:2)

Then touched he their eyes, saying, According to your faith be it unto you. (Matthew 9:29)

And immediately Jesus stretched forth *his* hand, and caught him, and said unto him, O thou of little faith, wherefore didst thou doubt? (Matthew 14:31)

Then Jesus answered and said unto her, O woman, great *is* thy faith: be it unto thee even as thou wilt. And her daughter was made whole from that very hour. (Matthew 15:28)

*Which* when Jesus perceived, he said unto them, O ye of little faith, why reason ye among yourselves, because ye have brought no bread? (Matthew 16:8)

And Jesus said unto them, Because of your unbelief: for verily I say unto you, If ye have faith as a grain of mustard seed, ye shall say unto this mountain, Remove hence to yonder place; and it shall remove; and nothing shall be impossible unto you. (Matthew 17:20)

Jesus answered and said unto them, Verily I say unto you, If ye have faith, and doubt not, ye shall not only do this *which is done* to the fig tree, but also if ye shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; it shall be done. (Matthew 21:21)

And he said unto them, Why are ye so fearful? how is it that ye have no faith? (Mark 4:40)


And he said unto her, Daughter, thy faith hath made thee whole; go in peace, and be whole of thy plague. (Mark 5:34)





# Capernaum in Jesus' Day






# Peter's House in Capernaum
