- Life; animation
- active power
- heart, affection

SOUL in Bible: used 458 times

(5315: Hebrew: Nephesh)

- A breathing creature
- Vitality; self; person; mind; living being
- That which breathes, the breathing substance or being
- The inner being of man
- Seat of emotions, passions, appetites
- Activity of mind; will; character

Substance:

(1828 Webster's Dictionary)

- being; something existing by itself
- that which really exists
- the essential part; the main or material part
- something real; not imaginary; something solid
- body
- goods; estate; means of living

Infinite:

- Without limits
- Unbounded; boundless; not circumscribed
- That which has no end; infinitely extended
- Indefinitely large, immense, great size
- Immeasurably

- opposed to bad, imperfect, corrupted, impaired
- having moral qualities best adapted to its design and use, or the qualities which God's law requires;
- virtuous; pious; religious;
- conformable to moral law
- sound, perfect, uncorrupted, undamaged
- full, complete, useful, kind, benevolent

the heaven of Soul: very atmosphere of Soul: harmony; the reign of Spirit; government by divine Principle; spirituality; bliss

the capacity of Soul: no overwork, no strain, no inability

the beauty of Soul: no ugliness in character or body, no spot where God is not, perfect glow and radiance and light; creativity, music, etc.

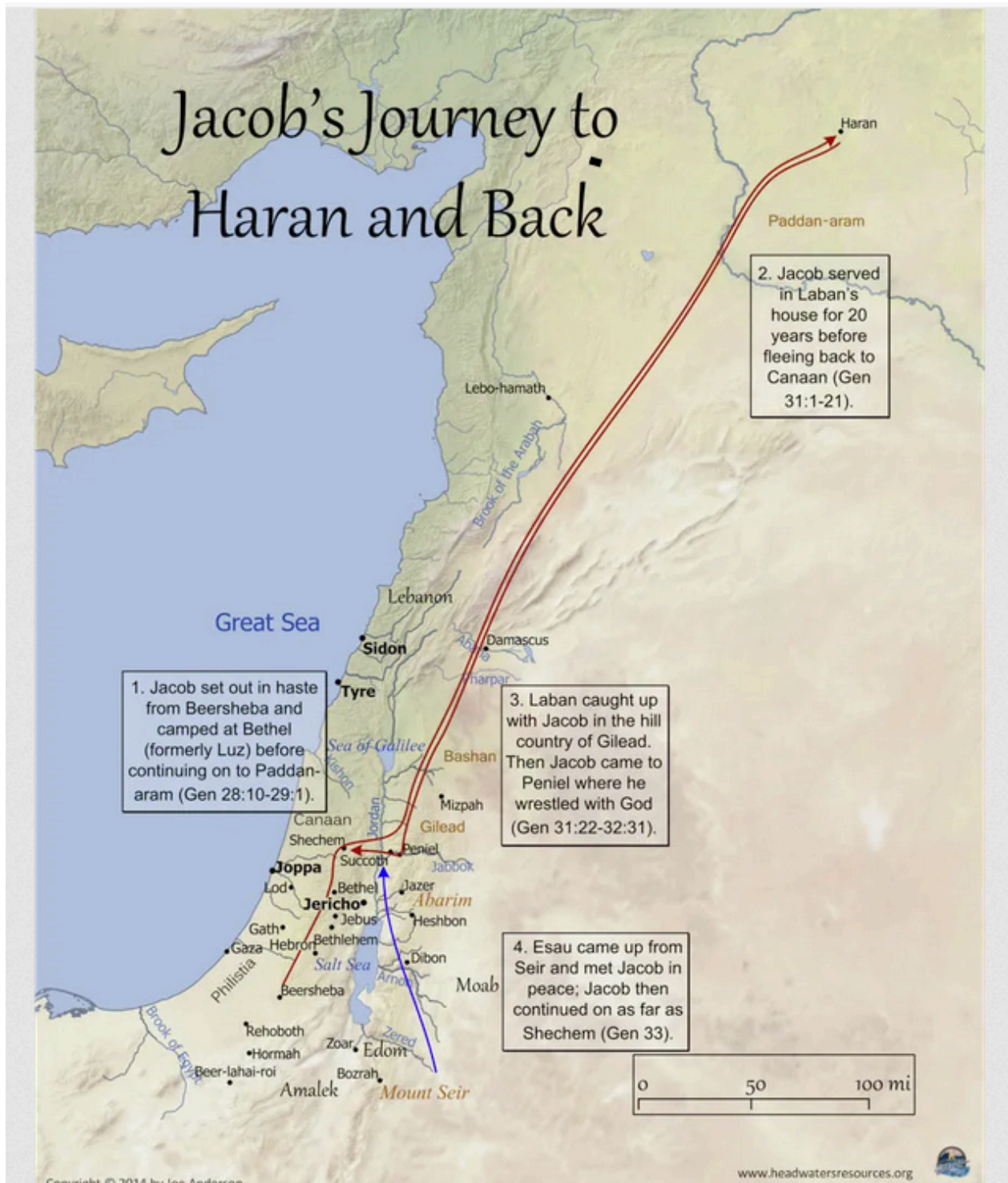
the unchangeable nature of Soul: no variance or changeableness, Soul is constant, uninterrupted perfection

The government of Soul: include laws of perfection and harmony; man is controlled incessantly by these laws; can't experience discord

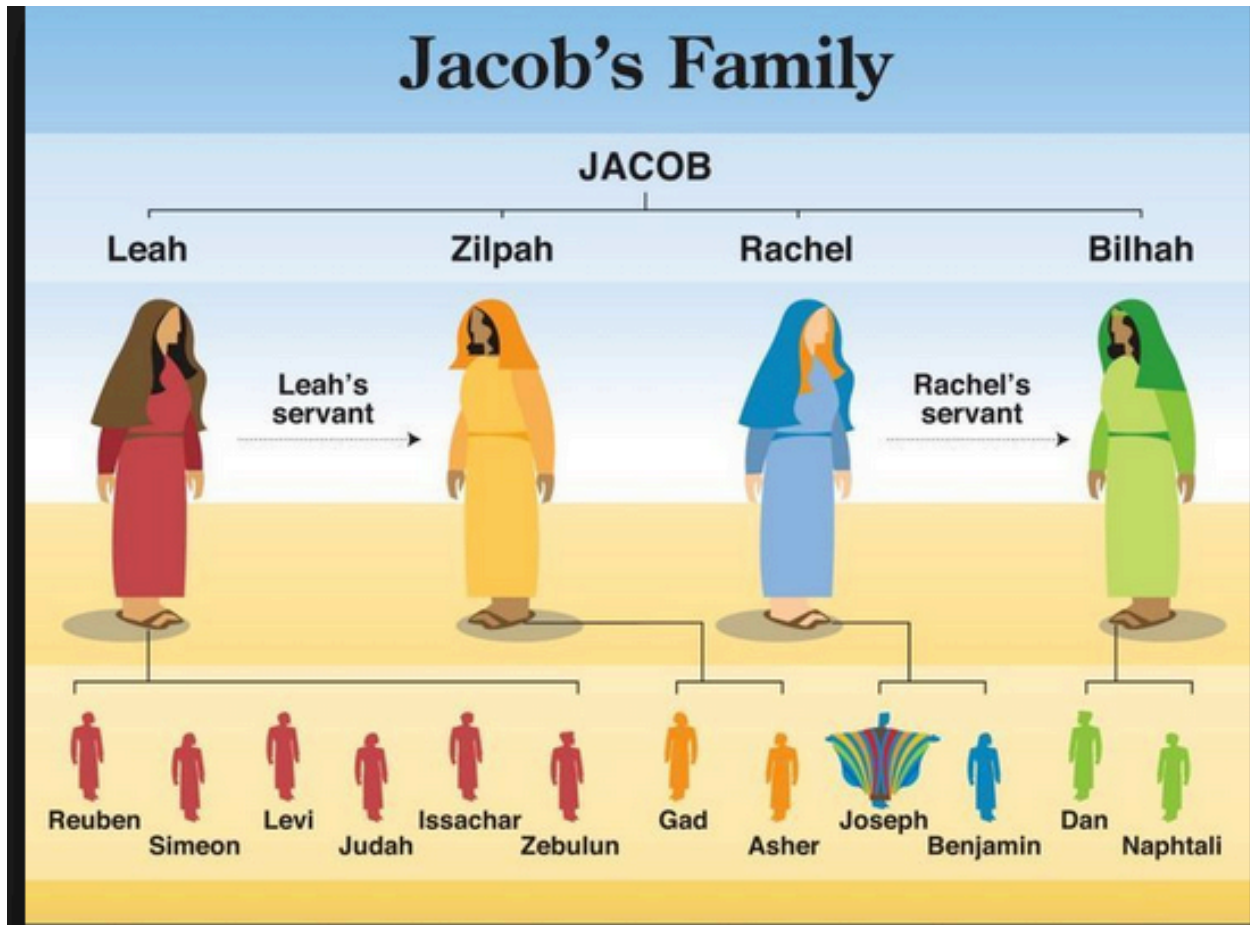
The senses of Soul: spiritual sense; no belief in material sense; vision, hearing, speaking, knowing, all belong to infinite Soul
