## Eccl 3:14, 15

14I know that, whatsoever God doeth, it shall be forever: nothing can be put to it, nor any thing taken from it: and God doeth it, that men should fear before him.

- Whatever God doeth,

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- whatever He has created is already perfect, from "when the morning stars sang together and all the sons of God shouted for joy," (Job 38: 7)
  - creation is a grand chorus or concert of angels praising God and celebrating His glorious creation
- the creation morn
- His creation is perfect, whole, complete, beautiful
- God governs the universe and nothing can change that, add to it, take away from it
  - Perfection doesn't need to be fixed
  - My vision, my health, my church, my body is absolutely perfect even though temporarily it might seem otherwise
  - We aren't restoring sight or health or repairing it: Jesus says 'receive' it just accept perfect sight; it's already present.

15That which hath been is now; and that which is to be hath already been; and God requireth that which is past.

- What hath been is now: The Genesis I version of spiritual creation including spiritual man is NOW!
- Perfect vision, perfect health, perfect movement, perfect supply, intelligence. Whatever hath been (it was created in Genesis I before the morning stars and is now!)

- And that which is to be hath already been: no future perfection, just right now.
- We are never trying to get to a destination, we are already there.
- Perfection is a present, spiritual divine fact.
- A fact is a fact always has been and will be. It's a law, the Truth.
- I can see what God is revealing. I'm yielding to Truth every step of the way. No resistance to it.

I am already what I'm praying for. It is already done.
