day and the daystar, shone upon the hearts of men, the light by which the prophets themselves had been enlightened and which was necessary to the full perception of the true meaning of their prophecies, 2 Pet. 1:19

Phos: Greek 5457 (God is light and in him is no darkness at all. I John 1:5)

- 2. heavenly light such as surrounds angels when they appear on earth
