Notes on the Word:

WORD can mean the whole Bible, which we even call the WORD OF GOD or THE SCRIPTURES

Torah, Pentatauch, or the law, specifically the first five books of the Bible or the ten commandments.

Logos means the eternal principle or order in the universe It is attached to many of the physical sciences,

so Logos, or the Word can mean Science. Think of biology, zoology, psychology, physiology, etc.

Water and the Word are synonymous symbols in the Scripture.

Isa 55: For as the rain cometh down..... So shall my Word be...

Whenever you see any form of water, think about it being the Word of God: fountain, stream, rivers, spring, sea, well, etc. etc.

Genesis I tells us everything is created through and by the Word of God- first principle, the creative action of Genesis I, which we know to be the core and banner over the whole Bible.

In Genesis I, it declares 10 times - "God said, God said, God, said"....that's the Word.

We all have a deep commitment to the inspired word, (the new tongue) the spiritual meaning of the Scriptures, which we are repeatedly commanded to study and pursue, and it has to include its practicality.

Characteristic of the Word:

Word is always synonymous with action.

"God spake and it was done." "He commanded and it stood fast."

Misc 280:1, Mrs. Eddy writes "Mind spake and form appeared."
no space in between, no process, no recovery time, no
recuperation, just powerful declaration, and immediate results.
